# General information

This booklet offers you a detailed overview of TOP Winter Week 2025, which will take place on January 21 through 23. TOP Winter Week is all about introducing new students to the Netherlands, the city of Tilburg, life as a student in Tilburg, and to their fellow students. With two or three mentors, you will guide a group of approximately 20 people.

# Important information

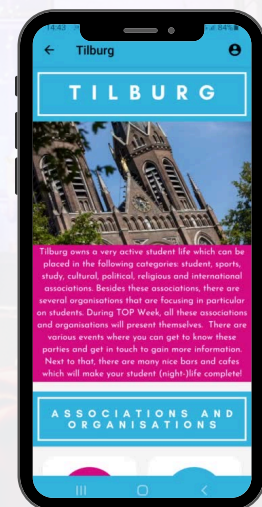
## TOP Week application

The TOP Week app contains all the information you need for TOP Winter Week. It is also essential for registration as it contains your QR code, and the application is used for communicating announcements during TOP Winter Week. You can open the app on your smartphone, but also via your desktop.

You will receive an e-mail about creating an account for the TOP Week application the weekend before TOP Winter Week. Make sure to download it and create an account before the start of TOP Winter Week. You can download the app in the App Store or the Google Play Store by searching 'TOP Week'.

The application has many handy features, like seeing your personal TOP Winter Week program, information about all sorts of associations in Tilburg, a chat with your group, and a map of Tilburg with all student hotspots.

**Please note:** the application will be open for all participants and mentors the weekend before the start of TOP Winter Week. Make sure to keep an eye on our socials for the exact date and time of the launch.





## TOP wristband

During registration on Tuesday, January 21, 2025, you will receive a TOP wristband. This wristband serves as your admission ticket throughout the Week, so make sure you wear it at all times. Once you have received this wristband, put it on and don't remove it for the rest of the Week! If you lose your wristband, you will have to buy a new one. This will cost € 25. If your wristband is ripped, torn, or broken, you can get a new one for free by showing your old, broken wristband to one of the TOP board members, together with your QR code and passport/ID card. You can recognize TOP board members by their bright blue (sweat)shirts. It is not possible to buy a new wristband if the original one was taken away by the TOP board.

You receive a wristband according to your age. All wristbands will be checked at the entrances to TOP activities. The TOP organization, Security staff, and/or bar personnel are allowed to ask for identity cards to verify your age.

We ask all mentors to behave with dignity and responsibility. Together we can make sure all participants have a great TOP Winter Week. It is your job as a mentor to keep an eye on your under-age group members and to make them feel just as enthusiastic about TOP Winter Week as the group members who are allowed to drink.





## Smoking policy at Tilburg University

Tilburg University is a smoke-free campus. This entails that smoking (e-)cigarettes is not allowed on the Tilburg University campus and in its sports facilities.

## Alcohol policy

Our alcohol policy is completely in line with legal regulations outlined by Dutch Law:

1. Selling or serving alcohol to individuals under 18 is strictly prohibited.
2. If you provide alcohol to an underage participant or mentor, your wristband will be taken away and you will be banned from becoming a mentor in the future.
3. Individuals under 18 can face legal consequences for possessing and/or consuming alcohol in public places, including streets, pubs, shopping malls, train stations, or parks.
4. Infringing these rules will be punished irrespective of the alcohol percentage of the drink involved.

## Drugs policy

The TOP Foundation applies a zero-tolerance drugs policy. If you are caught using, carrying, or selling drugs, you will be excluded from all our events and the police will be informed. If there is any suspicion of drug use, security personnel is allowed to search you and you may be refused entry. However, if there are serious medical issues concerning drug abuse, you should always call the Dutch emergency number: 112. You will not get arrested, as using drugs is not prohibited in the Netherlands.



## Transgressive behaviors

If you experience transgressive behavior during TOP Winter Week or elsewhere, there are several organizations that you can contact for support. The TOP board members are always available to help and guide you in this.

In the event of sexual violence, you can contact one of the following authorities: Police (112 for emergencies / 0900-8844 if it is not an emergency) or the Sexual Assault Center: 0800-0188. All phone numbers are available 24 hours a day.

Tilburg University also has a confidential advisor whom you can contact if you want to further discuss your experience in a safe place. More information about the confidential advisors can be found [here](#).

## Sports Center membership

In order to join the ice-skating activity during TOP Winter Week, you need a Tilburg University Sports Center trial membership. The trial membership is free and allows you to access the ice rink and one free session at the Tilburg University Sports Center. For admission to the activity and the Sports Center, you will need to download the Sports Center Tilburg application. Find more information about memberships and the application via [this](#) link. Please create an account and download the application before the start of TOP Winter Week. ***Make sure your TOP group has also done this before coming to this activity! This is essential.***

**Please note:** if your TOP group decides to participate in the ice-skating activity, and you, as a TOP mentor, do not have any free sport sessions remaining or a sports membership, TOP will cover the admission fee.



## WhatsApp group

The weekend before TOP Winter Week, you will receive a list per e-mail with the telephone numbers of the students in your group. Please make sure to create a WhatsApp group chat before TOP Winter Week starts. By doing this, you can make clear agreements with everyone and all students will know how to reach their mentors.

There will also be a WhatsApp group chat with all mentors, where only the TOP organization will be able to post messages to make sure no one misses any last-minute communication. If you want to contact TOP for any questions, please send a private message or give us a call at + 31 6 42 09 21 70.

## WhatsApp group for exchange students

For all ESN mentors guiding an exchange group, it is slightly different. You will get a list from the International Office with a group of students who will only go to the program introductions on January 20 and not attend TOP Winter Week. You can create a separate group chat for this. Make sure you keep the TOP Winter Week group chat separate during TOP Winter Week. You can merge these two groups after TOP Winter Week is over.

## Sleeping accommodation during TOP Winter Week

As a mentor, it's your responsibility to ensure that participants have accommodation during TOP Winter Week. You can offer them a place to stay in your home, based on available space. Additionally, use the group chat to check if any participants in your TOP group already have a room in Tilburg and are willing to host group members.

If there is a genuine lack of available space, you can suggest Hostel Roots as a last resort. However, consider this option only if all other avenues for accommodation have been explored.



## Buying drinks during TOP Winter Week

You need to buy TOP tokens to pay for drinks during TOP activities. The price per TOP token is € 2.15. The first opportunity to buy these tokens is at the TOP ON at ESN. Activities where TOP tokens are accepted include: TOP ON, Tilburg Winter Fair, Dinner at Koepelhal, and the TOP Winter Cantus. Make sure you bring enough cash and your bank card to all the other activities to buy drinks.

## Buying food during TOP Winter Week

All dinners are included in the participation fee.

You can buy food and snacks at the Tilburg Winter Fair and at the Ice-Skating activity on Wednesday. Pathé cinema sells snacks on Wednesday. Make sure you bring enough cash and your bank card to these activities to buy food. Only at Registration and during Cluedo on Tuesday, and the Sports Activity and during the City Stroll on Thursday are you allowed to bring your own food. At all the other activities, bringing your own food or drinks is not allowed.

**Please note:** breakfast, lunch, and drinks are not included in the participation fee.





# Important dates

## Registration Day

The Registration Day is on Friday, January 17, 2025. This day is organized by Tilburg University to give new students a warm welcome and to make sure they have enough time to arrange practical matters. Especially international students are encouraged to join this day, as all kinds of services will be provided to make sure they have a relaxed and well-organized start in Tilburg. Among other things, they can get information about opening a bank account in the Netherlands. If you guide a group of exchange student, please encourage your group members to go to this website to give them the best start in the Netherlands.

**Please note that the following two activities are mandatory for all students:**

## Program Introduction at Tilburg University

The International Office of Tilburg University organizes a Program Introduction on Monday, January 20. This Program Introduction will introduce new students to all the practical matters of their studies at Tilburg University. For more information, please contact the International Office. Contact details can be found at the last pages of this booklet. Please note that the Program Introduction is not part of TOP Winter Week and we are not involved in organizing it.



## Registration

On Tuesday, January 21, the registration for TOP Winter Week 2025 will take place at the Sports Center (Academielaan 5, 5037 ET Tilburg). Please make sure you bring your passport or ID and that you have downloaded the TOP Week application. The application contains a QR code that is needed for registration. Please note that you do not need the e-ticket from your TOP account, but the QR code from the app. At the registration, you will receive a wristband and a goodie bag. The wristband gives you access to all TOP Winter Week activities.





# Guiding your group

All TOP Winter Week participants will be assigned to groups. This year, TOP groups will consist of approximately 20 students. Your task is to support your group members if they ask you to. Do they need help with the application? Do they have questions about certain TOP activities? Do they have study-related questions? Please do your best to help them or direct them to someone who can answer their questions. Try to involve all students in your group, so that they will be able to connect with their fellow students.

Most participants don't know much about Tilburg or the Netherlands in general and it is your job to guide and help the new students adjust to their new lives in Tilburg. The process of moving to and studying in a new city or country – as well as coping with a new cultural environment – can take some effort getting used to.

## Different cultures

People from all over the world are participating in TOP Winter Week. Consequently, you will have to take into account many different cultures and behaviors. Good communication is essential to creating a pleasant atmosphere within your group and to making sure that everyone has a great week. Also make sure you speak English at all times if you have a group that consists of both Dutch and international students, so nobody feels left out.

## Guidelines and tips

Make clear agreements with your fellow mentor and take your responsibility. As a mentor, you are responsible for your group members that week, so make sure you take that responsibility seriously. Make clear agreements about how you will act in certain potentially problematic situations. For example: what do you do if group members do not like the same type of activities.



Make sure you know the program and inform your group members about the different activities. For your group members, all activities are new, and they don't know what to expect. Please tell your group members what is on the program, what (not) to bring, and what they can expect.

Follow the program of TOP Winter Week and be on time. Remember that participants paid for TOP Winter Week. TOP organizes this week for these new students, and it is your job as a mentor to make sure they can join every TOP activity if they want to.

Please be open-minded and show new students as much as possible. Make sure that you do not only show them what you like but show them as much of student life and Tilburg as possible. Listen to the needs of ALL the students in your group.

Be enthusiastic and well-prepared and stay positive! It is you and your fellow mentor who set the mood. Make sure you have a good icebreaker game at the start of the week to get to know each other. In this way, you will create a good team spirit and a more connected group.

Reach out to your group by sharing your background and experiences. Encourage an active dialogue by asking open-ended questions and try to answer their questions.






# House rules

1. Obey the instructions given by the TOP organization and security.
2. Entry to events will only be given to participants visibly wearing the TOP wristband and age wristband provided by the organization.
3. Purchased entry tickets/wristbands will not be refunded by the organization.
4. Entering the location of the TOP events is at your own risk.
5. You are obliged to carry a valid ID card/passport at all times.
6. TOP has a zero-tolerance alcohol policy: No alcohol < 18 years old
7. TOP has a zero-tolerance drug policy. It is not allowed to use or carry drugs. Entry will be refused if there is a suspicion of any drug use. Your TOP Wristband may be taken away if you break any of these rules.
8. TOP has a zero-tolerance weapons policy. It is strictly prohibited to use or possess weapons.
9. Bringing your own food or drinks to TOP activities is not allowed, except when explicitly stated otherwise.
10. You are not allowed to enter locations for which you are not authorized.
11. You may be searched prior to and during events. Those who do not submit to this may be denied entry. When you refuse to be searched and/or have your bag checked, the TOP organization and/or security will deny you access to the event.
12. The TOP organization and security have the right to refuse access to TOP events.
13. No alcohol will be served to people who misbehave or are unduly intoxicated.
14. During the introduction week, visual materials will be captured. By entering the premises, you give your consent for this.

15. If you injure people and/or damage buildings and equipment, you will be liable to any damages. The TOP organization and/or its employees cannot be held accountable for any injuries and/or damage.
  16. No disturbances, unwanted intimacies, or disruptive behavior are allowed.
  17. If you are refused access to one of the TOP events, regardless of the reason, you have no right to a refund of any fees.
  18. In case of not complying to the rules above, the organization is forced to take measures.



# What to bring

There are some important things you will need to bring every day: a bicycle, cash money and/or your bank card, and your phone so that you can keep in contact with your fellow mentor and your group. Remember that it might be cold, so please make sure you wear warm clothes. Also make sure to bring some party clothes for the TOP ON and the open parties. Other things you will need to bring on specific days include the following.

## Tuesday

Bring your phone with the TOP Week application that holds your QR code and your passport or ID card.

Please wear comfortable shoes and warm clothes since you will be walking through the city during the Real Life Cluedo.

## Wednesday

Bring your phone to the ice rink with the Sports Center application that holds the free sport session. Please also wear warm clothes and socks to the ice rink. Wearing gloves and a hat is mandatory for safety reasons.

## Thursday

If you decide to participate in the sport clinics, please wear comfy or sports clothing and bring a water bottle and a small snack.

We advise you to wear comfortable shoes and warm clothes during Tilburg Through Your Eyes since you will be walking through the city.

**Please note:** we highly recommend encouraging your TOP group members to get a bike, as this will make TOP Winter Week much easier for both you and your group members.



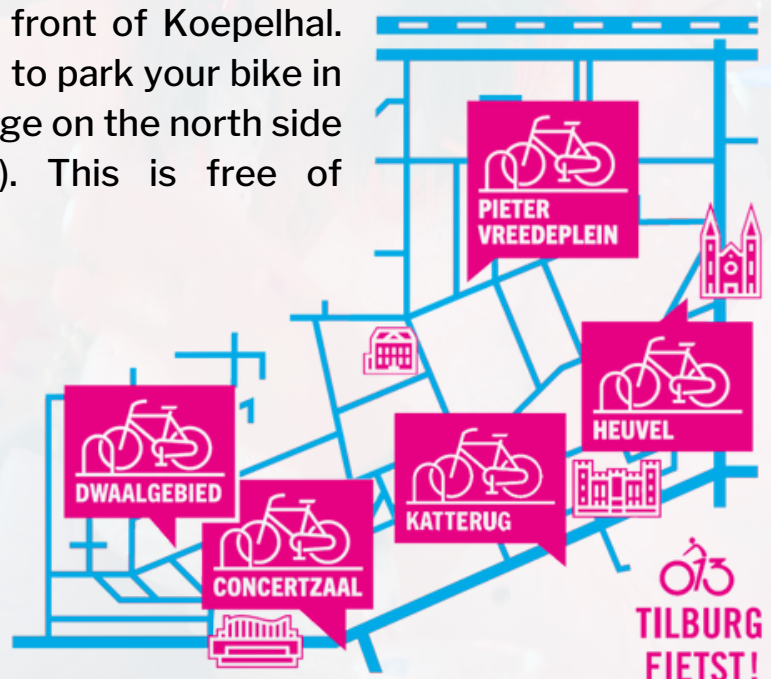
# Bicycle parking

You can only park your bike in the bicycle stands and in the free bicycle parking stations at the following locations.

- Heuvel: Heuvel 35
- Katterug: Stadhuisplein 115
- Pieter Vreedeplein: IJzerstraat 20
- Concertzaal: Louis Bouwmeesterplein 1
- Dwaalgebied: Bleshof 24
  
- NS Bicycle Storage: Willem II-passage 15
  - At the station, there is a guarded bicycle parking facility on Spoorlaan and another at the rear of the station near the Lochal. You can park your bike there for free for the first 24 hours.

## Please note the following:

- During Registration you can park your bike on the grass opposite of the Sports Center.
- During the TOP Winter Cantus do not park your bicycle in front of Koepelhal. You are only allowed to park your bike in the NS Bicycle Storage on the north side (NS stalling Noord). This is free of charge.

**Location:** ESN

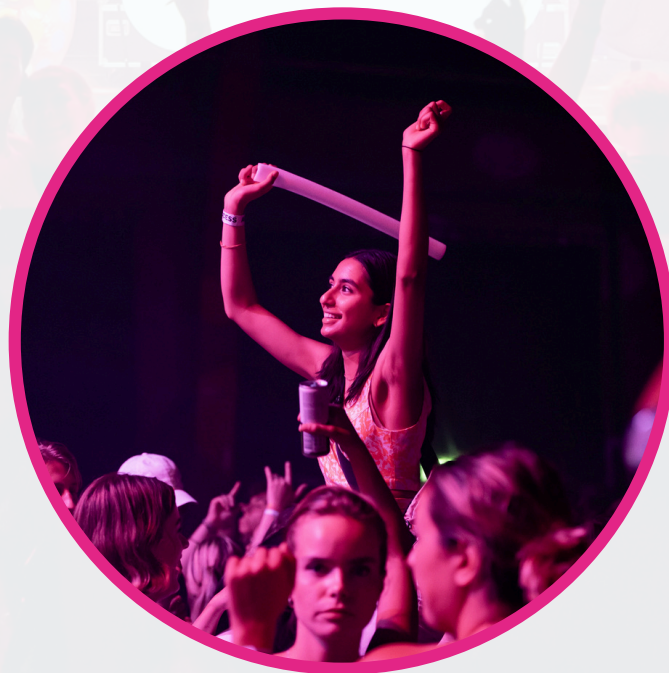

Skates are available to borrow free of charge, but don't forget to wear gloves (mandatory) and a hat (highly recommended). As part of this activity, take on a special Eleven Cities Tour-inspired challenge: collect stamps on your stamp card as you skate and immerse yourself in a unique winter adventure!

**Please note:** you only have FREE access to this activity if you have registered for a trial sports membership. If you would like to continue ice skating after this week, you can purchase a sports membership. ### *TOP Winter Fair*

**Time:** 14:00-18:00

**Location:** Koepelhal

The TOP Winter Fair takes place in Koepelhal. This afternoon, there will be all kinds of fun activities for you to do, to familiarize yourself with various kinds of associations and other parties in Tilburg. At the TOP Winter Fair, you will get a taste of some typical Dutch games and you will also have the opportunity to try some Dutch food.

At the start of the TOP Winter Fair, you will receive a stamp card. You get a stamp at every stand you visit, and every sport you participate in. If you visit all the stands, and thereby collect all the stamps, you can win a prize!

## **TOP Winter Cantus**

The TOP Winter Cantus, to be held at Koepelhal, is famous among students in Tilburg. It is an activity in which the participants sing along with lots of famous songs (such as Neil Diamond's *Sweet Caroline* and Billy Joel's *Piano Man*, but also some typically Dutch songs) and drink beer, wine, or soft drinks together. Alcohol-free beer will also be available. Be aware that you have to be at least 18 years old to participate in the TOP Winter Cantus. There are lockers to store your belongings. Please keep in mind that you will have to pay for a locker. Refreshments during the TOP Winter Cantus can only be bought by your mentors with TOP tokens. Remember not to wear your best or newest clothes to the Cantus. Close off TOP Winter Week with a bang!

## **Game Night**

**Time:** 19:00-22:30

**Location:** Hostel Roots

If you are not yet 18, or prefer a non-alcohol related activity, we refer you to the Game Night at Hostel Roots as an exciting alternative to the TOP Winter Cantus. Here, you can enjoy playing a variety of games and connect with fellow participants in a relaxed and friendly atmosphere.



# Cantus rules

The TOP Winter Cantus is the highlight of the introduction week and will make sure the week ends on a high. At the start of the Cantus, all mentors and participants gather near the toilets in the Wagenmakerij. When all external parties are seated, you all walk down the middle aisle behind the Cantus band with your group flag, that you have created at the TOP Winter Fair.

The event is accompanied by some strict Cantus rules. We expect you to pay attention to them and make sure your group knows these rules as well. The table below shows prohibited actions and their consequences (warning or removal). Two warnings will result in removal.

Removal	Warning
Smoking inside	Unpleasant drunk behavior
Fighting	Standing outside the benches
Peeing outside of the toilets	Drinking when the band is playing
Throwing up	Leaving the table with the whole group
Throwing beers or pitchers	
Standing or jumping on benches or tables	
Singing 'eins, zwei, drei, saufen' and the song that comes after	

**Please note:** people are allowed to go to the bathroom during the Cantus. Once you exit the venue, you are not allowed to re-enter again.
